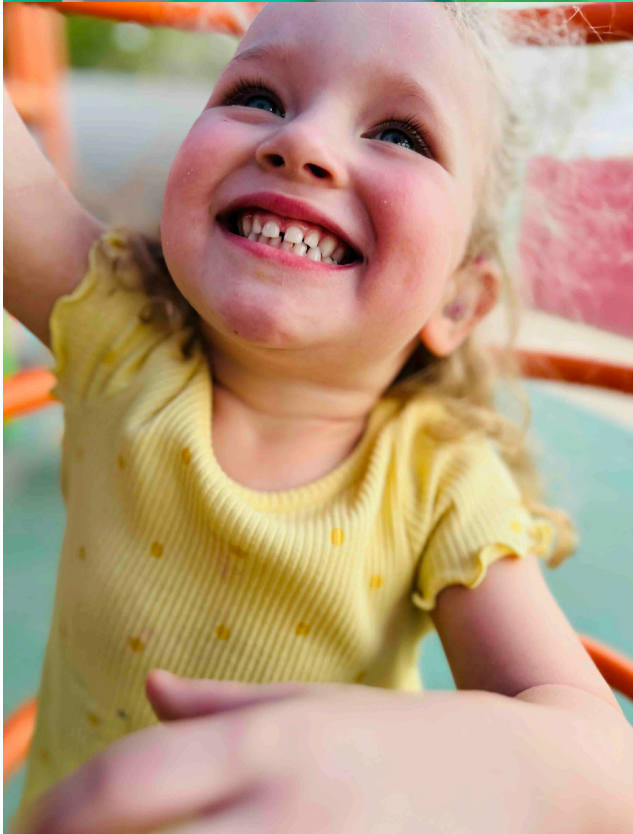

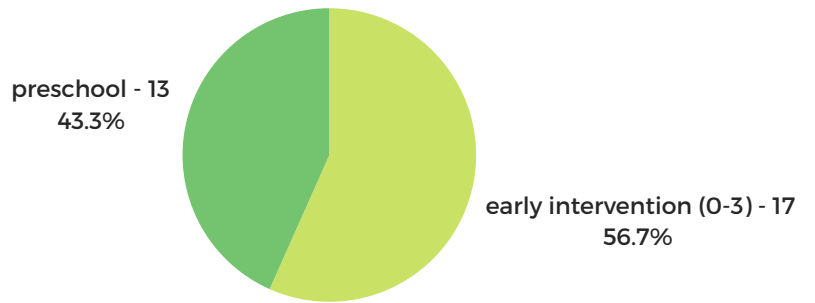

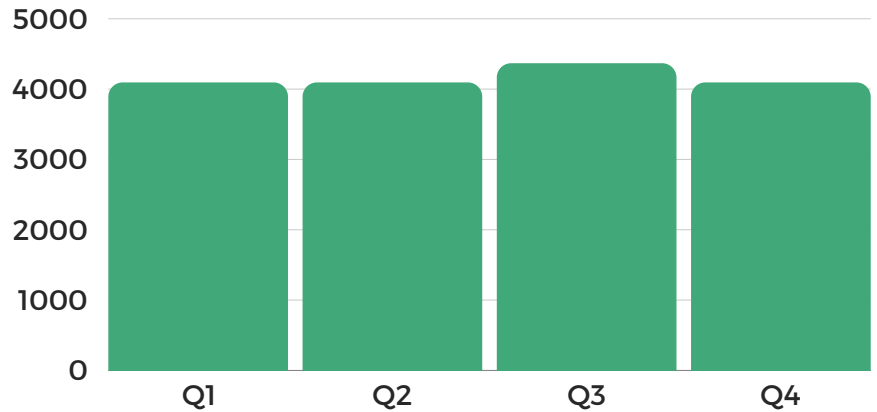


## Families Served



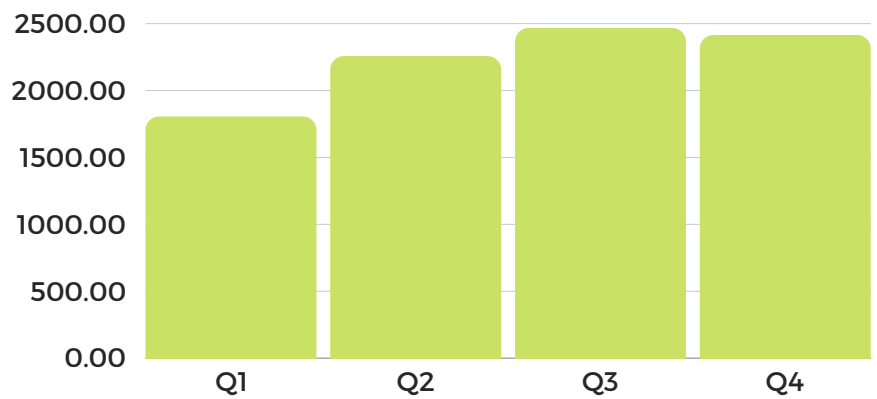
## Hours of Services Provided

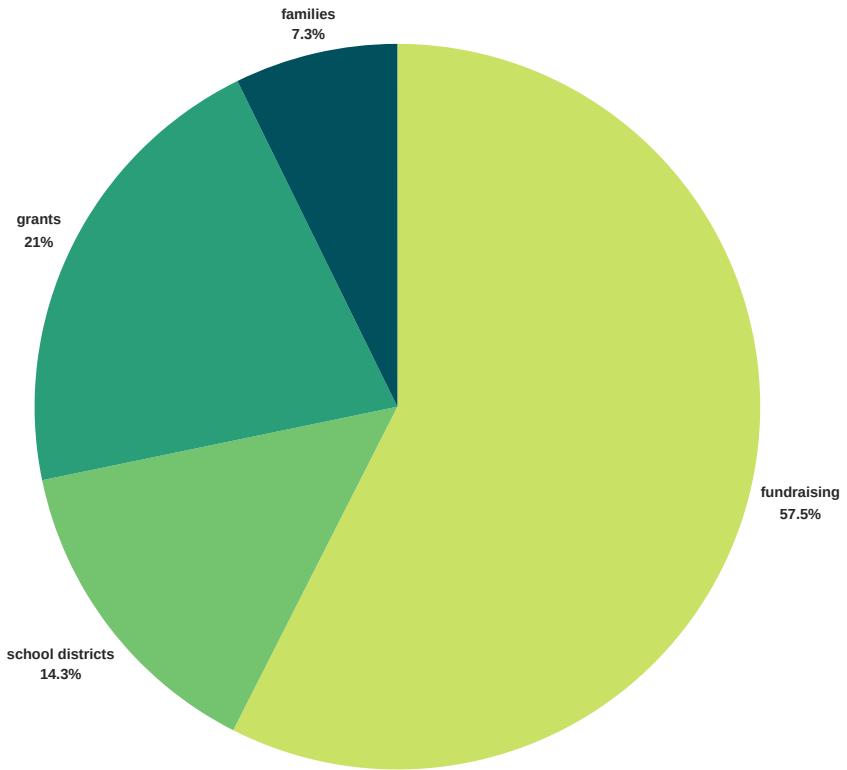

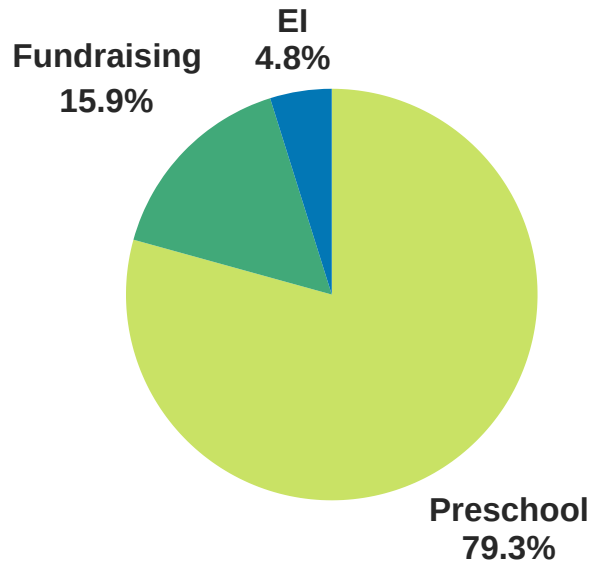

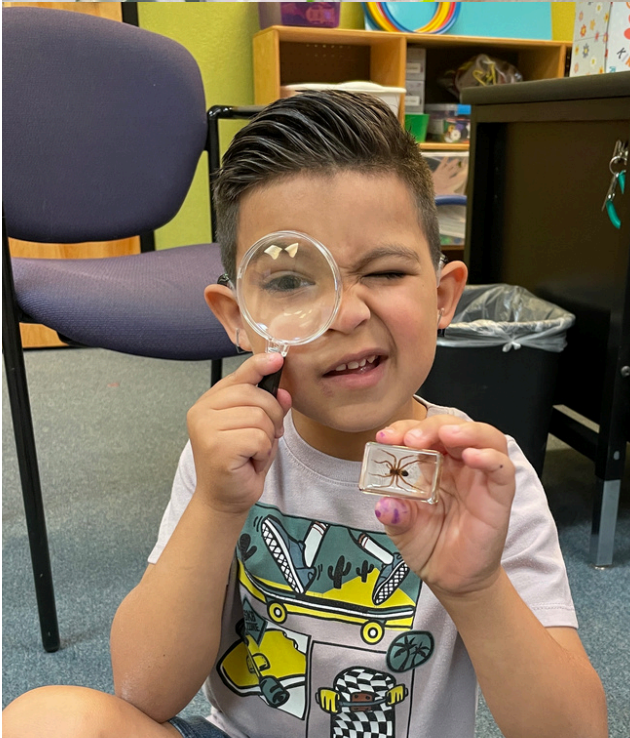


## Greyson
